Bilkent University was founded in 1984 as Turkey's first private, nonprofit institution of higher education. The university has 12,000 students seeking degrees in 30 undergraduate and 59 graduate programs. The use of English as a medium of instruction contributes a great deal towards the University's truly international perspective. The faculty is comprised of academic staff from over 38 different countries. There is a growing body of full-time international students, as well as international exchange students visiting from more than 370 partner institutions.

International Exchange Programs

Bilkent University welcomes exchange students from all over the world. The Office of International Exchange Programs organizes an orientation program that includes a campus tour, Turkish language courses, workshops, residence permit applications and course registration for incoming exchange students.

The Office of International Exchange Programs runs the Erasmus Program with participating partner universities all around the world and strives to help international students with all administrative, academic and practical issues. It also plays a central role in establishing and maintaining relations with international partner institutions worldwide.

Campus Life

Bilkent is a hub of academic, social, and cultural activity. Bilkent has a lively campus atmosphere with plenty of cultural and social events taking place throughout the year.

Food

Bilkent campus and nearby areas feature a wide variety of eateries, cafeterias, kiosks, cafes, and coffee shops for enjoying a quick snack or a full meal with friends.

Entertainment, Culture, and Community

The world-renowned Bilkent Symphony Orchestra gives weekly performances during the academic year. The annual Spring Festival is a time for fun and friendship. Radio Bilkent sponsors many activities on campus. Around 100 student clubs are active in a wide variety of areas. Located a short walk off campus are entertainment and shopping facilities that include a multiplex cinema, a bowling alley, boutiques, and salons.

Sports Activities

Indoor and outdoor sports facilities enable students to participate in their choice of activities and competitive events. The campus features three sports halls with modern fitness centers, as well as athletic fields, tennis courts, and a semi-Olympic indoor swimming pool. Bilkent has become the first university in Turkey to be awarded the Gold Certificate by the FISU Healthy Campus program.

Health Services

Two health centers provide health care to all students, faculty, and administrative staff. Physicians and nurses are available 24 hours a day for emergency care.

Transportation

Transportation services are provided free of charge for all students between the campus and the city center via University shuttle buses on a scheduled basis. Ring shuttle buses also run regularly between the Main and East Campuses.
